My report on the field testing of the emergency radio package, held on 28,29 June 1986 is as follows.

All of the radio equipment, antennas, generator etc worked at full efficiency for the full twenty four hours.

I would suggest that a new handle be installed on the jack of the EMO trailer, just behind the towing hitch, as the existing handle is badly worn and it is possible to pinch ones hand.

It would seem that one of the generators has been removed from the trailer and I would suggest that it or another be replaced, therefor providing a backup should the existing generator fail.
